## **Primary School**

#### Dear Parents,

We would like to express our sincere thanks to all the parents who visited us for our coffee morning, where we shared our current improvements and new initiatives for this academic year.

### A Glance at our School Year so far:

This year at Reach British School we have introduced a new robust assessment system that is aligned to the standards/outcomes of the National Primary Curriculum of England. Past SAT papers are used to gauge student attainment against the norm. After the collection of this data in September, which is referred to as a baseline, our senior leaders and teachers analyse the current levels of each student and provide them with an aspirational target and the next steps in how



to achieve their targets. These individualized targets support each student in reaching their full potential. This type of assessment is regarded as attainment (summative assessment) – a level that allows us to see how our students are doing in respect to their peers, in school, nationally and internationally.

Teachers also use continuous assessment for each student. This assessment tells the teacher and the students how they have done in relation to the learning outcome of the lesson/unit. Students will understand if they are on level (fully understand), above level (have mastered) and below level (need more time to understand). In our report cards for each trimester, parents will be informed if their children are O – On level, A – Above Level, or B – Below level.

#### How have we used our baseline data?

Teachers have arranged their students into different ability groups. Each teacher plans carefully, to ensure students can access the learning, at their level. Sometimes students with similar needs are grouped together to be taught the same concept, sometime they have individual learning planned for them. We have introduced Mathletics and Reading Eggs to help support each student achieve their potential. Both these programs are individualised to each student's particular needs. Students can access their individual work anywhere in the world at any time using a smart device.



### Positive Behaviour Policy:

This year we have also updated our positive behavior policy — Behaviour for Learning Policy. This policy has been shared with all parents and students so that we all work together for the best interest for the students. Class Dojo is the main tool we use for communicating student's positive behaviours as well as making parents aware of some mis-behaviours. We aim to encourage and celebrate the positive behaviours we wish to see around the school.

### Academic ECA's:

Another new initiative is the introduction of Academic Extra Curricular Activities (ECA). Teacher have selected specific students who have been identified by our data analysis in
